

Hertz offers electric bike rental scheme in London



The rise of the electric bike continues! The e-bikes cost GBP 20 per day to hire, which includes full training, a lock, optional helmet and a copy of the AA Leisure Guide to London with suggested bike rides around the city. If successful, Hertz says the scheme could be extended to other bike-friendly cities such as Amsterdam.
