

Tiny vending machine dispenses healthy snacks to toddlers



We've already seen one [vending machine](#) that's designed to dispense treats just to adults, so it seems only fair that there should be another one aimed specifically at kids. Sure enough, UK-based children's food brand [Ella's Kitchen](#) recently unveiled a tiny snack vending machine designed for young kids.

Ella's Kitchen's machine stands 115 cm tall and is just the right size for most toddlers, according to a [report](#) on FoodBev.com. Offering 12 varieties of healthy snacks, the device reportedly even features several tyke-oriented features designed to make it easy for toddlers to operate independently. It was apparently trialled at UK children's festival [LolliBop](#) in August.
