PD.ID IS A DATE RAPE DRUG DETECTING LAB IN YOUR POCKET

Currently seeking funding on Indiegogo, pd.id is a small kit that enables anyone to check if their drink has been spiked.

Unfortunately, we live in a world where women — and even men — feel more comfortable on a night out if they carry some form of protection against sexual assault. We recently wrote about [Guardian Angel](#), the jewelry that sends a fake call to wearers' smartphones to help them get out of uncomfortable situations. Now [pd.id](#) is a small kit that enables anyone to check if their drink has been spiked.

Currently seeking funding on Indiegogo, the device is a discrete finger-sized probe that can fit into a purse or pocket. The stick can be placed into any beverage in order to determine if it's been tampered with. A sample is collected in a small reservoir and a sensor then analyzes three qualities of the drink in order to identify its makeup — light, electrical current and temperature. Utilizing methods used by the US DEA, the device can determine the molecular constitution of the drink in a few seconds. Users can either check the built-in LEDs — which flash green for all clear and red for tampered — or the pd.id app to find out more about what's in their drink, even down to the exact drug.

pd.id could help stop people of any age or gender from becoming the victim of a date rape by giving them the tools to check what's in their drink. Backers can pre-order the device for USD 100 through Indiegogo until 29 August. Are there ways to catch those who use date rape drugs to commit sexual assault before they attack?
